NOTICE OF CONSUMMATION

RE: Proposed Abandonment and Discontinuance of Service over a portion of the Stoddard Industrial Lead from Milepost 0.90 to Milepost 1.75, a total distance of 0.85 miles in Canyon County, Idaho; STB Docket No. AB-33 (Sub-No. 294X)

Dear Ms. Brown:

This is to advise that in accordance with 49 CFR 1152.29(e)(2), as of September 23, 2014, the Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UP"), with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption, has consummated the abandonment of the Stoddard Industrial Lead from M.P. 0.90 to M.P. 1.75 in Nampa, Idaho, a total distance of 0.85 miles in Canyon County, Idaho. This Notice of Consummation is pursuant to authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board's") decision with a Service Date of August 30, 2013 and the subsequent decisions with Services Dates of September 30, 2013 and April 28, 2014, under which trail use negotiation periods under 16 U.S.C. §1247(d) and 49 C.F.R. §1152.29 were granted through and including September 25, 2014. UP decided to consummate the abandonment after the UP and the City of Nampa, Idaho were unable to reach a mutually acceptable trail use agreement.

A copy of this notice of consummation of abandonment is being served concurrently upon the Idaho Transportation Department, 3311 W. State Street, P.O. Box 7129, Boise, Idaho 83707-1129.

In accordance with the Board's decision prior to commencement of any salvage operations, UP will (1) consult with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) regarding potential impacts to water of the United States, including wetlands, and comply with the

reasonable requirements of the Corps and (2) in the event that any unanticipated archaeological site, human remains, funerary items or associated artifacts are discovered during UP's salvage activities, UP will immediately cease all work and notify OEA and the Idaho SPHO pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 800.13(b).
