Revocation of Consummation Notice


Dear Ms. Brown:

On November 19, 2014, the City of Belfast filed a Consummation Notice regarding abandonment and railbanking of the Belfast and Moosehead Lake Railroad from MP 0.33 located in downtown Belfast, Maine at the U.S. Route 1 overpass to MP 2.33 ("City Point") located at Oak Hill Road, also located in the City of Belfast. The Consummation Notice was filed in error based upon a mistaken belief that the Board's April 30, 2014 decision required such notice despite the fact that an NITU had been issued.

Please consider this letter to be the City of Belfast's official revocation of the Consummation Notice filed on November 19, 2014.
