Dear Ms. Brown:

This request is filed on behalf of the Pottawattamie County Conservation Board (public agency) and the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation (non-profit corporation), which are parties interested in conservation and recreation, and are hereinafter referred to as "Proponent."

Proponent requests issuance of a Notice of Interim Trail Use rather than an outright abandonment authorization for the Iowa Interstate Railroad (IAIS) rail line between **milepost 467.77 near Hancock to milepost 469.59 near Oakland** in Pottawattamie County, Iowa.

The railroad right-of-way in this proceeding is suitable for railbanking and interim trail use. The corridor is identified as the potential Pedal-Paddle Trail on the Pottawattamie Countywide Trail Plan. Proponent makes the following statement:

STATEMENT OF WILLINGNESS TO ASSUME FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY: In order to establish interim trail use and rail banking under section 8(d) of the National Trails System Act, 16 U.S.C.1247(d), and 49 C.F.R. 1152.29, Proponent is willing to assume full responsibility for management of, for any legal liability arising out of the transfer or use of, and for the payment of any and all taxes that may be levied or assessed against the right-of-way owned by Iowa Interstate Railroad, Ltd. after transfer of the corridor to the public agencies.

FILING FEE WAIVED

The Pottawattamie County Conservation Board (public agency) and the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation acknowledge that the use of the right-of-way is subject to the user's continuing to meet its responsibilities described above and subject to possible future reconstruction and reactivation of the right-of-way for rail service.

The property extends from milepost 467.77 near Hancock to milepost 469.59 near Oakland. The right-of-way is part of a line of railroad proposed for abandonment in STB Docket No AB414-7X. A map depicting the right-of-way is attached.

On behalf of the Pottawattamie Conservation Board and the Iowa Natural Heritage Foundation, thank you for your consideration of this petition.


