This letter is submitted on behalf of KCVN, LLC ("KCVN"), one of the complainants in this proceeding. As explained in the filings in this case to date, since early 2014 KCVN has been highly interested in purchasing the line of railroad at issue—referred to by the parties as the Towner Line—for the purpose of reinstating common carrier freight service over the line. The complaint in this proceeding was prompted in part by the V&S Railway, LLC's ("V&S") efforts to thwart this objective.


The purpose of this letter is to inform the Board that KCVN, in addition to continuing to pursue this formal complaint action against V&S with the other named complainants, intends to submit to the Board an application for an order requiring V&S to sell the Towner Line (to be further defined in the application) to KCVN, or an entity created by KCVN for this purpose, under 49 U.S.C. §10907 and the regulations at 49 C.F.R. Part 1151. It is KCVN's expectation that this application will be submitted to the Board on or before August 1, 2015.
