NOTICE OF INTERIM TRAIL USE AGREEMENT

The City of Belfast hereby notifies the Surface Transportation Board that it has, by action of the City Council, agreed to allow and itself conduct interim recreational trail use of a portion of the line known as the Belfast and Moosehead Lake Railroad Company which extends from milepost 0.33 at the U.S. Route 1 overpass in the City of Belfast to milepost 2.33 near Oak Hill Road in the City of Belfast, Waldo County, State of Maine.

A map of the subject portion of right-of-way over which the City will assume recreational trail use is attached hereto as Exhibit A. The trail shall occupy all of the rail line subject to the Decision of the Board served April 30, 2014 in the above entitled docket.

The City of Belfast, a municipality, is the owner of the portion of the Belfast and Moosehead Lake Railroad Company rail line that is the subject of the above docket number, as well as the entity that will manage the recreational trail within the right-of-way.



FORMER B&MLRR TRACKAGE DESIGNATED FOR RECREATIONAL USE


