My name is Bryan Winther. I am the Vice President of the Delaware Express Co., 802 Elkton Blvd. I have served in this capacity since [October] of [2011].

Delaware Express Co. is a premier bulk non-hazardous materials transporter. Delaware Express' corporate office and main terminal in Elkton, MD is strategically located to serve the Mid-Atlantic region. Four additional terminals located in DE, NJ, NY, and MA further support our clients. Our drivers and support staff are capable and loyal and rewarded accordingly. The resulting low employee turnover and stable workforce provide our customers consistently superior service.

On August 31, 2016 Genesee & Wyoming Inc. ("G&W") filed with the Surface Transportation Board a Petition for Exemption to acquire control of Providence and Worcester Railroad Company ("P&W"), a Class III railroad operating in Massachusetts.

I understand that G&W-owned railroads provide freight service to many areas that otherwise would have no access to the national rail network without short line service and that Genesee & Wyoming Inc. has a very strong record of acquiring short lines throughout the United States, investing in the properties and growing business. I understand that G&W will continue to operate P&W as a separate railroad. However, I am sure the overall corporate focus, professionalism and the commitment to safety and service will definitely be beneficial for the P&W.

For these reasons, I strongly support G&W's petition and control of P&W, and ask for expedited review and approval of it by the Surface Transportation Board.
