Dear Ms. Brown:

On October 21, 2013, Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“NSR”) filed a verified notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. pt. 1152 subpart F—Exempt Abandonments for NSR to abandon approximately 0.61 miles of rail line between milepost CB 4.80 (near East County Road 450N in Connersville, Fayette County, Ind.) and milepost CB 5.41 (near Whitaker Drive in Washington Township, Wayne County, Ind.). Notice of the exemption was served and published in the Federal Register on November 8, 2013 (78 Fed. Reg. 67,215).

NSR has complied with the conditions imposed by the Board in its subsequent December 9, 2013 decision (“Dec. 9th Decision”). Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 1152.29(e)(2), and the Board’s Dec. 9th Decision, NSR hereby advises the Board that it has exercised the authority granted and consummated abandonment of the Line.
