I'm a long time train passenger, and I travel on the trains serving the Midwest and East Coast. It is important to me, both as a passenger and as an advocate for the improvement of train service in the United States, that Amtrak be accorded preference over the freight trains, and that punctuality of passenger trains be measured at intermediate stations as well as stations at the end of the routes. Amtrak must be allowed to improve the timeliness and punctuality of its' trains in order to accommodate passengers' needs, and to be considered as a viable alternative to automobile travel.
