
STB Ex Parte No. 754OVERSIGHT HEARING ON DEMURRAGE AND ACCESSORIAL CHARGES

NOTICE OF PARTICIPANT SUBSTITUTION

On April 24, 2019, Sims Metal Management Limited (“SMM”) filed its notice of intent to participate in the hearing on demurrage and accessorial charges, notifying the Board that Mr. Steve Shinn, Vice President of SMM would present SMM’s testimony. On May 3, 2019, the Board issued its scheduling order indicating that the hearing will occur over a two-day period on May 22-23, 2019, Mr. Shinn is scheduled to appear on Panel IX on May 23, 2019.

SA RECYCLING LLC


Mr. Bobby Triesch is the Vice President and Regional General Manager of SA Recycling LLC (“SAR”). SAR is a full-service ferrous and non-ferrous metal recycler and processor. SAR is also a member of the Institute of Scrap Recycling Industries (“ISRI”). SAR operates over 70 recycling facilities located throughout California, Texas, Arizona, Nevada, Georgia, Alabama, and Tennessee. Rail transport is a vital part of SAR’s supply-chain and SAR has a strong interest in this proceeding.

Mr. Triesch hereby notifies the Surface Transportation Board (“Board”) that he intends to address the following issues pertaining to railroad demurrage practices and accessorial charges during his testimony on May 23, 2019:

- Railroad service issues related to implementation of Precision Railroad Scheduling (“PSR”).
- Impacts related to the reduction of free time for private cars.
- Inability of SAR to make operational changes or additional investments to avoid the demurrage/storage charges.

- Need for reasonable railroad rules and practices, including reciprocal commitments, that establish appropriate efficiency incentives for both rail customers and railroads.
