I am writing in opposition to the application filed by the Estate for George M. Hart for an Adverse Abandonment. Please consider this a protest/opposition statement. I would like to ask that all 7.4 miles of the Stewartstown Railroad to remain intact and for the complete denial of their Adverse Abandonment Application.


As a technology company, we plan to complete a 10+ year project in which we will acquire old locomotives, recycle what we can, refurbish them with proprietary green technology, and then resell or lease them. We plan to set up our base our base of operations in Southern York County along the Stewartstown Railroad's tracks within the next few years.

Based upon our projections, we anticipate to ship: 12 carloads of scrap metal per year, receive 10 carloads of parts and supplies from various railroad vendors per year, and receive / send 5 locomotives per year depending on demand.

Rail service is very essential to the needs for this project. The shipping costs alone to send and receive parts by rail including: locomotives, engines, traction motors, batteries, wheels, and truck assemblies would significantly increase if they had to be moved by tractor-trailer as special permits, escorts, and other drastic measures would be required.

I understand the Stewartstown Railroad has some obstacles to overcome. I feel confident that amongst our projected traffic and with that from other shippers, sufficient demand exists for rail freight service. I have also verified with York Rail/Genesee and Wyoming, Inc. that a link to the national rail network exists that would connect us up from the Stewartstown's tracks via Yorkrail to NS and CSX.
