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**CHICAGO TERMINAL RAILROAD COMPANY’S MOTION TO WITHDRAW  
MOTION TO COMPEL**

Chicago Terminal Railroad Company (“CTM”) hereby withdraws its Motion to Compel, filed on September 18, 2017 (“Motion”).<sup>1</sup> CTR’s Motion sought to compel various discovery responses from Alloy Property Company, LLC (“Alloy”) in this proceeding. Alloy filed a Reply to the Motion on October 5, 2017. On October 25, 2017, the Board assigned all discovery disputes in this matter to Administrative Law Judge Patricia E. Hurt. Judge Hurt has scheduled a discovery status conference for Thursday, February 1, 2018 at 10:00 am.


CTM and Alloy have entered into discussions likely to result in a resolution of the controversy in this matter. Further discovery is therefore unnecessary. Accordingly, no remaining discovery disputes exist between the parties for Judge Hurt or the Board to resolve. CTM irrevocably requests that Judge Hurt cancel the discovery status conference and that the Board and Judge Hurt accept CTM’s Motion to Withdraw its Motion to Compel.

Counsel for Alloy has informed undersigned counsel that Alloy consents to this Motion.
