
Dear Ms. Brown:

This refers to Docket No. AB-1087X, Grenada Railway LLC--Petition for Abandonment Exemption--in Grenada, Montgomery, Carroll, Holmes, Yazoo and Madison Counties, Miss., and to the unverified letter from Mr. Pablo Diaz, Executive Director of the Grenada County Economic Development District, dated September 30, 2011, in support of the request for hearing of the Mississippi Transportation Commission.

Please be advised that Grenada is not situated on the line of the Grenada Railway LLC between Milepost 622.5 near Grenada and Milepost 703.8 near Canton which is the subject of the Petition for Abandonment Exemption. The only stations on the approximately 3.5 miles of 81.3-mile the railroad line proposed to be abandoned situated in Grenada County are Tie Plant, which has no shipper, and Elliott, which has two shippers.
