Dear Ms. Brown:

On October 14th, 2014, the City of Knoxville, TN filed a request for Public Use Condition and a request for Notice of Interim Trail Use (NITU) between milepost 0KS 275.09 (valuation station 15304+87) and milepost 0KS 276.27 (valuation station 15368+89). By order dated November 4, 2014, the Board granted the request to implement interim trail use negotiations as specifically set forth in the order, for a period of 180 days commencing November 5, 2014, and ending May 3, 2015. The Board also granted extensions to October 30, 2015 and April 27, 2016.

The City of Knoxville has been in direct contact with CSX Transportation, Inc. and has now reviewed the appraisal from CSX Real Property, Inc. The City of Knoxville respectfully requests the Board grant another 180-day extension until October 24, 2016, or such time so indicated by the Board to allow for continued negotiations.

In addition, it is our understanding that the filing fee of \$450.00 is waived for Government Agencies requesting extension of NITU negotiations as to STB Docket No. AB-55 (sub-no. 736X) CSX Transportation, Inc.
