On February 6, 2015<sup>1</sup>, the Stark County Park District (“SCPD”) filed a letter with the Board seeking imposition of a 180-day public use condition, and establishment of a Notice of Interim Trail Use (“NITU”) to allow SCPD to engage in negotiations with Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“NS”) toward a possible trails use arrangement for the subject rail line, which extends from milepost EU 0.70 to milepost EU 2.00 in Stark County, Ohio.

NS was served a copy of aforementioned filing by SCPD. NS hereby notifies the Board that it is willing to engage in negotiations toward a possible NITU arrangement for the subject rail line, consistent with SCPD’s February 6<sup>th</sup> filing.
