Re: Request for 6-month NITU Extension for Negotiations with Alabama and Florida Railway Co., Inc. & CSX Transportation, Inc. – Abandonment Exemption – in Geneva, Coffee, and Covington Counties, AL: STB Docket Number AB (Sub-No. 1073X)

Dear Members of the Surface Transportation Board:

This request is filed by the Alabama Trails Commission, a public entity, hereinafter referred to as the “proponent.” The proponent remains engaged in discussions with CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX) and Alabama and Florida Railway Co., Inc. (A & F) toward the desired outcome for all parties, which is an agreement regarding acquisition and trail use of the rail line and interconnecting lines owned by CSX.

The STB has granted the proponent’s request in the past to impose interim trail use/rail banking to allow for negotiating the acquisition of the rail line for use. We are actively engaged in an appraisal process with a funding agency and will need time to finish this process. We hope that the board will continue to grant the NITU. CSX and A & F are amenable to this extension and continued negotiations. We would like a 6-month extension beginning on October 14, 2016 to give us more time with the funding agency.
