I am gravely concerned about the proposal to use the Reedsburg-Madison rail line in Wisconsin to transport frac sand. The health risks and environmental degradation for the communities along the line are unacceptable.

In addition, the line runs through Devil's Lake State Park, the largest and most visited park in Wisconsin, with approximately 2 million visitors per year. These visitors would be exposed to heavy concentrations of silica dust posing health risks as well as limited scenic visibility, in addition to the noise and disruption of the increased train movement through the park. This would basically ruin a geologically unique and very special public space.

Please deny approval to documents now listed on the STB 's docket.
