

As you now are aware, the STB-ordered formal mediation regarding the above-referenced matter was not successful in resolving the disputed issues. *See* Letter, dated July 17, 2014 but entered by the Office of Proceedings on August 19, 2014, from Lucille L. Marvin, Director, Office of Public Assistance, Governmental Affairs, and Compliance.

BNSF filed the Terminal Trackage Rights Application on February 27, 2013. During the year and a half since, shippers in West Lake Charles, LA, including CITGO, have continued to be denied direct access to BNSF service.

BNSF requests that the Board issue an order imposing a procedural schedule consistent with the one proposed in BNSF's Terminal Trackage Rights Application (BNSF-118, at 16-17).
