
RE: **Docket No. AB-55 (Sub-No. 625X), CSX Transportation, Inc.—
*Abandonment Exemption—in Preston County, WV***

Dear Ms. Brown:

In response to the letter dated February 23, 2015 by the West Virginia State Rail Authority (“West Virginia”), CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) agrees to a 180-day extension until August 1, 2015, to negotiate interim trail use/rail banking with West Virginia for the 6.78-mile portion of the line between Manheim, WV, milepost BAJ 3.0, and Preston, WV, milepost BAJ 9.78 (the “WV Line”). Most recently, the Surface Transportation Board granted an extension of time for CSXT and West Virginia to negotiate until February 2, 2015. See *CSX Transportation, Inc.—Abandonment Exemption—in Preston County, WV*, Docket No. AB-55 (Sub-No. 625X) (served August 25, 2014). CSXT has not consummated the abandonment of the WV Line.
