
Dear Ms. Brown:

The letter from the Mississippi Transportation Commission, dated January 15 and filed January 17, 2014, is most encouraging, and the Grenada Railway LLC (“GRYR”) is wholly supportive.

GRYR would just as soon not have to seek the Board’s authority to abandon its railroad line between Elliott and Canton, and it is pleased to learn that the Commission would like to explore all alternatives to the proposed abandonment, including working with the Mississippi Legislature.

That doing so may necessitate delaying the filing of protests or comments until April 28, 2014, is perfectly understandable, and GRYR agrees to the postponement request.
