
CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) agrees to the request in the letter filed March 18, 2016 by Carroll County Wabash & Erie Canal, Inc. (“CCWEC”) seeking a 180-day extension of time from the March 22, 2016 deadline to negotiate interim trail use/railbanking for the approximately a 0.60-mile rail line on CSXT between milepost 0QA 112.6, and milepost 0QA 113.2, in Carroll County, IN (the “Line”).

CSXT agrees to the requested extension of the interim trails use/rail banking negotiation period until September 18, 2016.

As provided in 49 C.F.R. § 1152.29(e)(2), the extension of the trail negotiation period until September 18, 2016, creates a regulatory barrier to consummation of the abandonment, which provides CSXT with an additional 60 days to consummate the abandonment to November 17, 2016, if trail negotiation is unsuccessful. CSXT respectfully request that the Board confirm that the extension of the consummation period as provided in the regulations applies in this instance.
