
Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1152.29(h), Greenville County Economic Development Corporation (“GCEDC”) and the County of Greenville, South Carolina (“Greenville County”) jointly notify the Board that GCEDC and Greenville County have reached an agreement on rail banking/interim trail use (“Agreement”) for the line subject to abandonment in the above captioned proceeding. The approximately 3.29 mile rail line subject to the Agreement, which was proposed for abandonment in this proceeding, extends from milepost AJK 585.34 in East Greenville, SC, to milepost AJK 588.63 in Greenville, SC. The rail line traverses United States Postal Zip Code territory 29607.




