Dear Ms. Brown:

On July 23, 2013, Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“NSR”) filed a verified notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. pt. 1152 subpart F—Exempt Abandonments for NSR to abandon approximately 1.0 miles of rail line (hereinafter, the “Line”) extending between milepost XK 299.3 (to the south of the intersection of Woodstock Ave. and Nebraska Ave.) and milepost XK 300.3 (near the intersection of Douglas Rd. and Dorr St.) in Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio. Notice of the exemption was served and published in the Federal Register on August 12, 2013 (78 Fed. Reg. 48,931).¹

In accordance with the provisions of 49 C.F.R. § 1152.29(e)(2) and the Board’s August 12, 2013 Decision, NSR hereby advises the Board that it has fully exercised the authority granted

¹ Due to delays in salvaging the line, NSR requested and received two consummation deadline extensions. NSR currently has until August 12, 2016 to consummate its abandonment authority.
