Dear Ms. Brown,

On January 31, 2014, the Mississippi Transportation Commission (“Commission”) filed a letter with the Surface Transportation Board (“Board”) for additional time in the above-referenced matter. The Commission requested that the Board defer the due date for filing protests and comments until April 28, 2014, to allow the Commission to work with the Mississippi Legislature and others towards finding alternatives to the proposed abandonment.

The Mississippi Legislature recently approved two bills which will provide funds to the North Central Mississippi Regional Railroad Authority (“NCMRRA”) for the acquisition of Grenada Railway LLC’s (“GRYR”) rail line. The NCMRRA now seeks a sixty-day extension from the current extended date of April 28, 2014. This extension will provide additional time for the NCMRRA and GYRY, collectively the “parties”, to negotiate the sale of the rail line and enable the parties to work out the necessary details to complete the transaction. Therefore, we respectfully request that the Board defer the due date for filing protests and comments until June 27, 2014.
