Dear Ms Brown:

I wish to ask for the Board's consideration of the following facts :

1. Caddo Valley Railroad Company (CVRR) has abandoned the Line. The rails and tracks have been removed. RR Crossing signs have been removed from highways.
2. The one year time period for the filing of the consummation is past. The abandonments have automatically expired.
3. The NITU has expired.
4. No one has assumed financial responsibility. There is no indication of who is responsible for the line. This leaves all the adjoining landowners at risk including towns with bridges and trestles.
5. I believe the 60 days grace does not apply in this instance.
6. CVRR is attempting to abuse the procedures of the Board.
