

Re: Notice of Consummation - STB Docket No. AB-33(Sub-No. 165X), Union Pacific Railroad Company - Abandonment Exemption - In Caddo Parish, Louisiana (Good Roads Lead at Shreveport, Louisiana)

Dear Mr. Williams:

This is to advise that the Union Pacific Railroad Company, with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption, has consummated the abandonment of the Good Roads Lead from Milepost 8.21 to Milepost 8.68 in Shreveport, Louisiana (the "Line"), pursuant to the authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board's") Decision dated March 14, 2001, served March 20, 2001 and effective March 22, 2001. This Notice of Consummation is provided in compliance with 49 C.F.R. § 1152.29(e)(2).

The Board's Decision of March 14, 2001 imposed (i) a 90-day geodetic survey notice condition to the National Geodetic Survey prior to disturbing or destroying any geodetic marker and (ii) an environmental notice condition to take appropriate measures to prevent ground water contamination and to consult with Mr. John Halle, OEA Environmental Scientist Manager, prior to salvage activities. Both notice conditions have been complied with in preparation for salvage of the Line.

An additional ten (10) copies of this letter are enclosed for the Board's use and distribution.
