Re: Notice of Consummation – STB Docket No. AB-33 (Sub. No. 185X), Union Pacific Railroad Company – Abandonment Exemption – in Pulaski County, Arkansas (Junction Bridge Line and Rock Street Industrial Lead at Little Rock and North Little Rock, Arkansas)

Dear Mr. Williams:

This is to advise that the Union Pacific Railroad Company with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption has consummated the abandonment of the Junction Bridge Line from Milepost 343.65 in North Little Rock to Milepost 343.02 in Little Rock, Arkansas and Rock Street Industrial Lead from Milepost 345.3 to Milepost 347.4 in Little Rock, Arkansas (the "Lines"), pursuant to authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board's") Notice served November 20, 2001, and in the Board's Decision served December 19, 2001 as of December 20, 2001.

The Board's Decision of December 19, 2001 imposed a geodetic survey notice condition, which has already been complied with in preparation of the sale and donation to the City of Little Rock and for salvage of the remainder of the Lines. An additional ten (10) copies of this letter are enclosed for the Board's use and distribution.
