

Dear Secretary Williams:

By decision served in the above-captioned proceeding on July 16, 2001, Grand Trunk Western Railroad Incorporated ("GTW") was granted an exemption for the abandonment of its 2.48-mile line of railroad extending from milepost 267.5, near Corunna Road (Michigan State Route 21), and milepost 269.98, near Grand Traverse Street, in Flint, Genesee County, Michigan. GTW's abandonment exemption became effective on August 15, 2001.

Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §§ 1152.29(e)(2) and 1152.60(e), GTW hereby provides notice that it exercised the authority granted herein and consummated abandonment of the subject line of railroad on June 20, 2002.
