Dear Mr. Williams:

The Union Pacific Railroad Company has received a request from the City of Marquette for an additional 60-day extension in which to complete negotiations for the acquisition of that portion of the Union Pacific's right-of-way in the Hoisington Subdivision and McPherson Subdivision between milepost 495.80 to 497.40 and milepost 531.40 to 530.60, respectively, for an interim recreational trail. The Union Pacific is willing to continue to negotiate with the City of Marquette concerning the acquisition of the subject property for interim recreational trail and supports the City of Marquette's request for an extension of the negotiation period for 60 days commencing September 3, 2002. A copy of the City of Marquette's request is attached hereto as Exhibit A and hereby made a part hereof.


Dear Secretary Williams:
