I am authorized by CSX Transportation, Inc. ("CSXT"), through its authorized representative, Bobbi League, to state that CSXT agrees to negotiate with TN Overhill for railbanking and interim trail use of the subject Right-of-Way. In fact, TN Overhill and CSXT have reached an agreement for such railbanking and interim trail use.


