**Re: Notice of Consummation - STB Docket No. AB-33 (Sub. No. 197X),
Union Pacific Railroad Company - Abandonment Exemption - In Santa
Clara County, California (San Jose Industrial Lead)**

Dear Mr. Williams:

This is to advise that as of October 14, 2003, the Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UP") with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption has consummated the abandonment for the remainder of the San Jose Industrial Lead from Milepost 19.60 near Valbrick to Milepost 22.3 at the connection with the Vasona Industrial Lead near Cahill, California, pursuant to authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board's") Decision and Notice of Interim Trail Use and Abandonment decided February 27, 2003, and served March 7, 2003. In an earlier letter dated April 7, 2003, UP consummated abandonment and reclassified to exempt industry track a separate portion of the San Jose Industrial Lead between MP 22.3 to MP 22.45.

The Board's decision in the above referenced matter imposed three conditions with regard to the abandonment of the Line. (1) Notification to the National Geodetic Survey, (2) A public use condition, and (3) A trail use condition. With regard to the first condition, UP will notify the National Geodetic Survey in preparation for salvage of the Line. With regard to the second and third conditions, both the public use condition and trail use condition have expired.

An additional ten (10) copies of this letter are enclosed for the Board's use and distribution.
