LATE FILED REQUEST FOR FILING PROTESTS AND WRITTEN COMMENTS

RE: Docket No. AB-838, East St. Louis Junction Railroad Company – Adverse Abandonment – In St. Clair County, IL 212081

Docket No. AB-33 (Sub-No. 199), Union Pacific Railroad Company – Adverse Discontinuance – In St. Clair County, IL 212082

Dear Mr. Williams:

By decisions served March 2, 2004, May 13, 2004 and Late Release July 15, 2004, the Board granted extensions of the due date for filing protests and written comments in the above proceedings to facilitate negotiations by UP, applicant Illinois Department of Transportation (“ILDOT”) and other railroads involved in the Illinois Route 3 project. UP and the other railroads are collectively referred to herein as (the “Railroads”).

Union Pacific Railroad Company (“UP”) respectfully requests an additional extension (from September 30, 2004 to January 14, 2005) of the due date for filing protests and written comments in these proceedings. In support of this request, UP states that the above parties are engaged in ongoing negotiations and that the Railroads have submitted a proposal to ILDOT which ILDOT is currently reviewing, and that such negotiations will not be concluded before the current September 30, 2004 due date. We are requesting an 106 day extension, because, given the multiple parties involved and ILDOT’s review of the Railroads’ proposal, it may take that period of time for all responses to be analyzed and mediated, if necessary. UP remains hopeful that the negotiations will prove successful, in which case UP would not oppose ILDOT’s application.




