Abandonment Exemption—in Wayne County, IN*

Dear Secretary Williams:

The Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Richmond, IN (“Richmond”) requested a notice of interim trail use/rail banking for approximately a 1.31-mile portion of rail line extending from railroad Milepost CI-61.90 to railroad Milepost CI-63.21 in Richmond, Wayne County, IN, in the above-entitled proceeding. The current extension of the negotiating period expires on June 25, 2005. CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) has not consummated the abandonment, has been unable to finalize negotiations with Richmond, and desires to continue to negotiate for interim trail use/rail banking with Richmond. Therefore, CSXT respectfully requests the Board to grant a 180-day extension of time to December 22, 2005 to negotiate trail use with Richmond. Additionally, CSXT respectfully requests an extension of the date to consummate the abandonment to February 20, 2006.
