The rail line is depicted in a map that is attached to this Notice as Appendix 1.







BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) and Minnesota Commercial Railway Company (MNCR) give notice that on or about July 11, 2005 they intend to file with the Surface Transportation Board, Washington, DC 20423, a Notice of Exemption under 49 C.F.R. 1152.50 from the prior approval requirements of 49 U.S.C. 10903 for BNSF to abandon its rail line that extends southerly from Milepost No. 7.19, a point approximately 100 feet north of Interstate Highway 694, to Milepost No. 6.52, a point approximately 50 feet north of Boom Avenue, a total distance of approximately 0.67 miles, all located within the Cities of Maplewood and Wild Bear Lake, Ramsey County, Minnesota, and for discontinuance of service over that line by MNCR pursuant to a lease from BNSF. There have been no shipments on that rail line for more than two years. The rail line proposed for abandonment traverses through United States Postal Zip Code 55109 in Ramsey County. The proceeding has been docketed as STB Docket No. AB-8 (Sub-No. 429X) and Docket No. AB-882 (Sub-No. 1X).

The Board's Section of Environmental Analysis (SEA) will generally prepare an Environmental Assessment (EA), which will normally be available 60 days after the filing of the petition for abandonment exemption. 

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL AND HISTORIC REPORT

Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1105.7 and § 1105.8, BNSF RAILWAY COMPANY (BNSF) and MINNESOTA COMMERCIAL RAILWAY COMPANY (MNNR) (referred to collectively as "Applicants") hereby file this Draft Environmental and Historic Report (Report). This Report constitutes Applicants' assessment of the environmental and historic effects of abandonment and discontinuance of rail service on the involved rail line. Persons who review this Report are entitled to provide comments to the Surface Transportation Board (STB), Section of Environmental Analysis (SEA), 1925 K Street, N.W., Suite 500, Washington, DC 20423. There is no information in the Applicants' files to indicate that the rail line covered by this Report contains federally granted right-of-way. *See* 49 C.F.R. § 1152.60(d). This Report has been prepared in conjunction with the prospective filing of a Notice for Exemption of abandonment and discontinuance of service on the involved rail line. STB regulations provide that the Notice of Exemption cannot be filed until at least 20 days after this Draft Report is submitted.

I.

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL REPORT

Applicants hereby submit the following information required by 49 C.F.R. § 1105.7(e):

(1) Proposed action and alternatives. Describe the proposed action, including commodities transported, the planned disposition (if any) of any rail line and other structures that may be involved, and any possible changes in current operations or maintenance practices. Also describe any reasonable alternatives to the proposed action. Include a readable, detailed map and drawings clearly delineating the project.

The proposed action is abandonment of, and discontinuance of rail service over, railroad right-of-way and trackage that extends southerly from Milepost No. 7.19, a point approximately 100 feet north of Interstate Highway I-694, to Milepost No. 6.52, a point approximately 50 feet north of Beam Avenue, a total distance of 0.67 miles, all located within the Cities of Maplewood and White Bear Lake, Ramsey County, Minnesota. That right-of-way and trackage will be referred to as "the rail line". Right-of-way and trackage that is not proposed for abandonment continues north from the identified point north of I-694. Right-of-way and trackage dead-ends at the identified point north of Beam Avenue. Attached to this Report as Appendix 1-A is a map of the rail line on which the line is shown in black. Attached to this Report as Appendix 1-B is a map which shows the rail line in relation to other rail lines in the area, on which the rail line has been shaded in yellow. Attached to this Report as Appendix 2 are several recent photographs of parts of the rail line.

The rail line is owned by BNSF and has been leased to MNRR for rail operation. Pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 10903, rail carriers require authority from the Surface Transportation Board (STB) for abandonment of rail lines and discontinuance of service over rail lines. However, pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 10502, the STB can exempt rail carriers from the requirement

of obtaining such authority in specified circumstances. Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1152.50, the STB has adopted a class exemption for abandonment of, and discontinuance of rail service over, rail lines on which no shipments have been originated or terminated in the previous 2-year period. The rail line qualifies for that class exemption. Applicants intend to file a Notice of Exemption for abandonment of, and discontinuance of rail service over, the involved rail line. However, STB regulations require that applicants circulate a Draft Environmental and Historic Report at least 20 days before the filing of such a Notice in order to permit interested governmental agencies and individuals to comment on the perceived environmental and historic effects of the proposed abandonment and discontinuance. This document constitutes that required Draft Report.

No commodities have been transported over the involved rail line in more than two years. The involved rail line is being abandoned in conjunction with a public works project involving realignment of County Road D in Maplewood, Minnesota. BNSF, MNNR, Northern States Power Company, d.b.a. Xcel Energy, the City of Maplewood, Ramsey County and Ramsey County Regional Rail Authority propose to enter into a County Road D Realignment Agreement in conjunction with that project. Pursuant to that Agreement, as here pertinent, it is anticipated that the track materials in the line will be removed^{1/} and sold for salvage and the real estate will be railbanked and be used as a recreational trail pursuant to the National Trails System Act, 16 U.S.C. § 1247(d). Pursuant to that Act, the right-of-way may be subject to future reactivation for rail freight use.

^{1/} Track materials were previously removed on part of the rail line near its southern end (see the photographs in Appendix 2).

There is a bridge by which County Road D formerly passed under the rail line. The area under the bridge span has been filled in with soil making the bridge unusable. That bridge will be removed in conjunction with realignment of County Road D following the effectiveness of an exemption for abandonment of the rail line. That bridge is more than 50 years old. Information regarding that bridge and photographs of it are provided in the Draft Historical Report, *infra*.

There is also a bridge over the rail line at I-694. Eventually, that bridge also will be removed after abandonment of the rail line is authorized. That bridge is less than 50 years old. It is not encompassed in the subsequent Draft Historic Report.

Inasmuch as no shipments have been transported over the involved rail line for more than two years, there have been no rail operations on the line and virtually no track maintenance during that period. Abandonment of the line thus will not result in a change in operations and maintenance.

There is no reasonable alternative to the proposed abandonment and discontinuance inasmuch as a portion of the involved rail line is required to be removed in conjunction with realignment of County Road D, and the line is not used nor required for rail freight transportation.

(2) Transportation system. Describe the effects of the proposed action on regional or local transportation systems and patterns. Estimate the amount of traffic (passenger or freight) that will be diverted to other transportation systems or modes as a result of the proposed action.

Applicants believe that the proposed abandonment will have no direct effect on regional or local transportation systems and patterns inasmuch as the rail line has not been used for rail transportation for more than two years. The proposed abandonment will have a positive indirect effect on local transportation patterns inasmuch as removal of a portion of the rail line will

enable County Road D to be realigned for the benefit of the motorized traveling public.

(3) Land use. (i) Based on consultation with local and/or regional planning agencies and/or a review of the official planning documents prepared by such agencies, state whether the proposed action is consistent with existing land use plans. Describe any inconsistencies.

Based on Applicants' review of a proposed County Road D Realignment Agreement, the proposed rail abandonment is known to be consistent with local and regional land use plans because the City of Maplewood and Ramsey County are parties to that Agreement, which contemplates abandonment of the rail line. This Draft Report is being sent to representatives of the City of Maplewood and Ramsey County for any comments they care to make. (See Appendix 3).

(ii) Based on consultation with the U.S. Soil Conservation Service, state the effect of the proposed action on any prime agricultural land.

Applicants do not believe that the proposed rail abandonment would have any effect on prime agricultural land. The involved rail line is not located adjacent to land that is in agricultural cultivation. In accordance with the Board's regulation, Applicants are consulting on that subject by letter with the Natural Resources Conservation Service, formerly known as the U.S. Soil Conservation Service. (See Appendix 4).

(iii) If the action affects land or water uses within a designated coastal zone, include the coastal zone information required by Sec. 1105.9.

Not applicable. The rail line is not located in a designated coastal zone.

(iv) If the proposed action is an abandonment, state whether or not the right-of-way is suitable for alternative public use under 49 U.S.C. 10905 and explain why.

Based on Applicants' review of the proposed County Road D Realignment Agreement, the involved rail line is known to be suitable for alternative public use as a recreational trail in

light of the assembled nature of the right-of-way corridor.

(4) Energy. (i) Describe the effect of the proposed action on transportation of energy resources.

The proposed abandonment of this out-of-service rail line will have no effect on transportation of energy resources.

(ii) Describe the effect of the proposed action on recyclable commodities.

The proposed abandonment will not result in an increase or a decrease in overall energy efficiency inasmuch as the rail line is not being operated at present and will not be operated following abandonment.

(iv) If the proposed action will cause diversions from rail to motor carriage of more than: (A) 1,000 rail carloads a year; or (B) An average of 50 rail carloads per mile per year for any part of the affected line, quantify the resulting net change in energy consumption and show the data and methodology used to arrive at the figure given. To minimize the production of repetitive data, the information on overall energy efficiency in Sec. 1105.7(e)(4)(iii) need not be supplied if the more detailed information in Sec. 1105.7(e)(4)(iv) is required.

Not applicable. There would be no diversion from rail to truck transportation.

(5) Air. (i) If the proposed action will result in either: (A) An increase in rail traffic of at least 100 percent (measured in gross ton miles annually) or an increase of at least eight trains a day on any segment of rail line affected by the proposal, or (B) An increase in rail yard activity of at least 100 percent (measured by carload activity), or (C) An average increase in truck traffic of more than 10 percent of the average daily traffic or 50 vehicles a day on any affected road segment, quantify the anticipated effect on air emissions. For a proposal under 49 U.S.C. 10901 (or 10505) to construct a new line or reinstitute service over a previously abandoned line, only the eight train a day provision in subsection (5)(i)(A) will apply. Applicants believe that the proposed abandonment does not require a permit under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. Applicants believe that the proposed abandonment will not adversely affect any designated wetlands or 100-year flood plains. Attached to this Report as Appendix 7 are copies of a National Wetlands Inventory Map and a Delineated Wetland Boundaries Map of the area of the involved rail line. In accordance with a Board regulation,

Applicants are consulting on that subject with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. (See Appendix 8).

DRAFT HISTORIC REPORT

Applicants hereby submit the following information required by 49 U.S.C. § 1105.8(d):

(1) A U.S.G.S. topographic map (or an alternate map drawn to scale and sufficiently detailed to show buildings and other structures in the vicinity of the proposed action) showing the location of the proposed action, and the locations and approximate dimensions of railroad structures that are 50 years old or older and are part of the proposed action;

The required topographic map is attached to this Report as Appendix 10.

(2) A written description of the right-of-way (including approximate widths, to the extent known), and the topography and urban and/or rural characteristics of the surrounding area;

The right-of-way to be abandoned is 150 feet wide and 0.67 miles in length. It extends through relatively flat suburban terrain.

(3) Good quality photographs (actual photographic prints, not photocopies) of railroad

structures on the property that are 50 years old or older and of the immediately surrounding area;

A series of photographs of the bridge at County Road D is attached to this Report as Appendix 11. That is the only structure on the rail line that is at least 50 years old.

(4) The date(s) of construction of the structure(s), and the date(s) and extent of any major alterations, to the extent such information is known;

The exact date of construction of the County Road D bridge is not known, but that bridge is thought to be at least 50 years old.

(5) A brief narrative history of carrier operations in the area, and an explanation of what, if any, changes are contemplated as a result of the proposed action;

The involved rail line was originally part of the main line of BNSF's predecessor, Northern Pacific Railway Company, between St. Paul, MN and Duluth, MN. Much of that main line has been abandoned. The involved rail line is now a portion of a BNSF branch line between M&D Junction (White Bear Lake, MN) and Beam Avenue in Maplewood, MN. (See Appendix 1-B). MNNR acquired trackage rights to operate over the involved rail line in 1990. *See Minnesota Comm. Ry., Inc. - Trackage Exempt. - BN RR Co., 8 I.C.C.2d 31 (1990).* MNNR leased the involved rail line and other rail lines in the area from BNSF in 1998. (*See Minnesota Comm. Ry. Co. - Lease & Oper. Exempt. - BNSF Ry. Co., 1998 STB LEXIS 96 (F.D. No. 33577, decision served April 10, 1998).*)

(6) A brief summary of documents in the carrier's possession, such as engineering drawings, that might be useful in documenting a structure that is found to be historic;

Applicants do not have any such documents.

(7) An opinion (based on readily available information in the railroad's possession) as to whether the site and/or structures meet the criteria for listing on the National Register of Historic Places (36 CFR 60.4), and whether there is a likelihood of archeological resources or any other previously unknown historic properties in the project area, and the basis for these

opinions (including any consultations with the State Historic Preservation Office, local historical societies or universities);

Applicants believe that the bridge under the rail line at County Road D does not meet the criteria for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The bridge is of ordinary construction and design. It has a span of only 25 feet and a width of 12 feet. The bridge is spanned with six steel girders, each with a depth of approximately 24 inches. The tracks are supported by transverse timber lagging spaced at roughly 12 inches on center. The bridge structure is supported at each end by concrete abutments and attached wingwalls. The height of the abutments and wingwalls could not be determined because of the depth of fill under the bridge.

Applicants believe that there is not a likelihood of archeological resources or any other previously unknown historic properties in the project area because the fill under the bridge was placed less than 50 years ago.

Applicants are consulting by letter to the Minnesota Historic Preservation Office (Appendix 12).

(8) A description (based on readily available information in the railroad's possession) of any known prior subsurface ground disturbance or fill, environmental conditions (naturally occurring or manmade) that might affect the archeological recovery of resources (such as swampy conditions or the presence of toxic wastes), and the surrounding terrain.

The bridge under the rail line at County Road D has been largely filled in with soil (see photographs attached as Appendix 11). However, that fill is unlikely to affect the archeological recovery of resources inasmuch as that fill was placed less than 50 years ago.








