Dear Secretary Williams:

The Knox County Commissioners (the “County”) requested a notice of interim trail use/rail banking in the above-entitled proceeding for an approximately 6.37-mile line of railroad, in CSX Transportation, Inc.’s (“CSXT”) Midwest Region, Louisville Division, Lake Erie Subdivision, extending from milepost BQ-25.90, at Mt. Vernon, to milepost BQ-32.27, at Fredericktown, in Knox County, OH. The notice of interim trail use/rail banking is now scheduled to expire on November 27, 2005. Because CSXT has been unable to finalize negotiations with the County, CSXT respectfully requests a 180-day extension of time to May 26, 2006 to negotiate trail use with the County. Additionally, CSXT respectfully requests an extension of the date to consummate the abandonment to July 25, 2006.
