Dear Mr. Williams:

By decisions served October 1, 2003, November 5, 2003, December 23, 2003, March 2, 2004, May 13, 2004, July 15, 2004, September 30, 2004, January 24, 2005 and July 20, 2005, the Board granted extensions of the due date for filing protests and written comments in the above proceedings to facilitate negotiations by UP, applicant Illinois Department of Transportation ("ILDOT") and other railroads involved in the Illinois Route 3 project. UP and the other railroads are collectively referred to herein as (the "Railroads").


Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UP") respectfully requests an additional extension (from April 1, 2006 to February 1, 2007) of the due date for filing protests and written comments in these proceedings. In support of this request, UP states that the above parties are engaged in ongoing negotiations and that the Railroads have submitted a proposal to ILDOT which ILDOT is currently reviewing, and that such negotiations will not be concluded before the current April 1, 2006 due date. We are requesting a 305 day extension, because, given the multiple parties involved and ILDOT's review of the Railroads' proposal, it may take that period of time for all responses to be analyzed

and mediated, if necessary. UP remains hopeful that the negotiations will prove successful, in which case UP would not oppose ILDOT's application.

Counsel to ILDOT has authorized UP to state that ILDOT has no objection to the requested extension.

An additional ten (10) copies of this letter are attached for the Board's files.
