

AB 303 (Sub No. 25X)**

Dear Mr. Williams:

The Stockbridge-Munsee Community ("Tribe") and Canadian National are still having discussions over the possibility of rail banking for the CN corridor in Wisconsin between mileposts SH 303 and SH 306.4. The Tribe desires to continue negotiating with CN regarding the possibility of rail banking.

Therefore, the Tribe requests that the Notice of Interim Trail use originally granted on December 24, 2002, and extended to May 10, 2006, be extended for an additional 180 days.
