I am the City Attorney for Camden Arkansas. This request is filed on behalf of the City of Camden, Arkansas, which is a political subdivision.

On June 27, 2006, the STB issued a Certificate of Notice of Interim Trail Use pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §1152.29. The 180-day negotiation period is scheduled to expire on December 29, 2006. **The City of Camden is requesting that the negotiation period be extended for another 180 days.** It is my understanding the Union Pacific Railroad concurs in this request.
