**Corrected Notice of Consummation**

Dear Secretary Quinlan,

By notice of exemption served in the above-captioned proceeding on April 23, 2007, Grand Trunk Western Railroad Inc ("GTW") was authorized to abandon its line of railroad extending from Milepost 7.06 to 6.36, a distance of approximately 0.7 miles, all in Orion Township, Oakland County, Michigan. GTW's abandonment exemption became effective on June 20, 2007. This revised Notice of Consummation is being sent to correct the letter dated January 24, 2008, wherein the mileposts were correct, but the distance between them was incorrect.

Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 1152.29(e)(2) and 1152.50(c), GTW hereby provides notice that it exercised the authority granted herein and consummated abandonment of the subject line of railroad on January 24, 2008.
