Dear Ms. Quinlan

On May 6, 2008, the Nebraska Trails Foundation, Inc. and the Papio-Missouri River Natural Resources District filed a request for interim trail use (NITU) on a 3.45-mile portion of the Union Pacific's Millard Lead, extending from Mile Post 22.85 in Omaha, NE to Mile Post 19.4 in LaVista, NE.

On May 15, 2008, Mack H. Shumate, Jr., Senior General Attorney for the Union Pacific filed a Partial Concurrence for Interim Trail Use stating that the railroad would agree with the NITU from Mile Post 22.1 in Omaha, NE to Mile Post 19.4 in LaVista, some 2.7 miles.

Mr. Shumate and I have discussed this change of Mile Post, and have agreed with the change.
