
Re: Union Pacific Railroad – Abandonment Exemption of Lenora Branch Line between Downs and Portis in Osborne and Smith Counties

We have reassessed the materials received August 5, 2008 regarding the above-referenced projects in accordance with 36 CFR Part 800. The role of the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) in reviews of this nature is to comment on whether or not an undertaking involving the use of federal funds will have an adverse effect on a historic property or a property eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. The SHPO has determined that the rail line and associated track, trestles, and culverts are not eligible for listing in the National Register, and as far as this office is concerned, the project may proceed.
