NOTICE OF CONSUMMATION

Re: Proposed Abandonment of the Trinity Industrial Lead from M. P. 0.0 near Terminal Junction to M. P. 4.1 near Mockingbird Lane, a distance of 4.1 miles in Dallas County, Texas; STB Docket No. AB-33 (Sub-No. 256X)

Dear Secretary Quinlan:

This is to advise that in accordance with 49 CFR 1152.29(e)(2), as of June 29, 2009, the Union Pacific Railroad Company, ("UP") with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption, has consummated the abandonment of the Trinity Industrial Lead from Milepost 0.0 near Terminal Junction to Milepost 4.1 near Mockingbird Lane, a distance of 4.1 miles in Dallas County, Texas, pursuant to authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board's") Decision served November 23, 2007. A copy of this notice is being served concurrently with the Texas Department of Transportation.

In accordance with the Board's Decision served November 23, 2007, prior to commencing any salvaging activities, UP did consult with the NGS. By Board decision served February 25, 2009, the Board granted the UP's request for an extension of time to consummate this abandonment to July 1, 2009. All conditions to consummation have been met or otherwise satisfied. UP hereby files with the Board this Notice of Consummation effective June 29, 2009 and prior to any disposition of any real property interests that make up the Line.
