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The Atlanta Development Authority (“ADA”), Atlanta BeltLine, Inc. (“ABI”), Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“NSR”), Georgia Department of Transportation (“GDOT”) and National Railroad Passenger Corporation (“Amtrak”) (collectively, “Movants”) hereby move this Board for an order extending for an additional 15 days the abeyance order entered by the Board on February 5, 2009, such that all aspects of both of these proceedings will be held in abeyance through and including March 23, 2009. The Movants have engaged in constructive discussions focused on finding a common solution that will accommodate the BeltLine vision and transit plan, as well as intercity and high speed rail in the region, but have not concluded those discussions. The Movants are hopeful that they will be able to address the issues that remain between them, and reach an agreement satisfactory to all, if they are given an additional 15 days to complete their discussions.


Accordingly, the Movants request the Board to issue an order:

1. Holding these proceedings in abeyance through and including March 23, 2009;
2. Requiring them to file, either individually or jointly as they may decide at the time, a status report with respect to their discussions by no later than March 23, 2009; and

3. Extending the schedule for filing responses in Docket No. AB-290 (Sub-No. 210X) such that the responses of ADA, ABI and NSR described in this Board's order dated January 21, 2009 in that proceeding will be due on March 27, 2009,¹ pending the conclusion of the above-mentioned discussions among the Movants.

WHEREFORE, ADA, ABI, NSR, GDOT and Amtrak respectfully request the Board to issue the order described herein.


