Dear Ms. Quinlan:

By decision dated September 8, 2008, the Surface Transportation Board issued a notice of interim trail use allowing the City of College Park, Georgia (the “City”) and CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) until March 12, 2009 to reach an agreement with respect to the 1.67 mile line of railroad on its Southern Region, Atlanta Division, Atlanta Terminal Subdivision in College Park, between Valuation Station 0+00 and the end of the line, Valuation Station 88+00, in Fulton and Clayton Counties, Georgia.

Although we have made considerable progress, the City has been unable to finalize negotiations with CSXT and desires to continue to negotiate for interim trail use/rail banking with CSXT. Therefore, an additional extension of time is being requested in order to conclude the acquisition of the property. The City hereby respectfully requests an additional 180-day extension.
