*Abandonment Exemption – in Logan County, WV***

Dear Acting Secretary Quinlan:

By decision served on September 18, 2008, the Board exempted from further regulation the abandonment by CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) of a 1.16-mile line of railroad on its Southern Region, Huntington Division East, Logan Subdivision, known as the Snap Creek Industrial Track, extending from milepost CLV 2.0 to the end of the line at milepost CLV 3.16 near Don, Logan County, WV (the “Line”). The exemption became effective on October 18, 2008.

Pursuant to the provisions of 49 C.F.R. 1152.29(e)(2), CSXT hereby files its notice of consummation signifying that it has exercised its abandonment authority and fully abandoned the Line as of the date of this letter.
