By notice of exemption served September 4, 2009, The New York, Susquehanna and Western Railway Corporation ("NYS&W") was authorized to abandon service over the Fay Street Branch between Milepost 284.80 at or near Oswego Street in Utica, New York, and Milepost 285.22 at or near Warren Street in Utica, New York. The exemption became effective on October 7, 2009.

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
