*Abandonment Exemption – in Niagara County, NY***

Dear Ms. Brown:

By decision served on December 31, 2008, the Board exempted from further regulation the abandonment by CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) of a 1.06-mile line of railroad, known as the Wurlitzer Industrial Track, on CSXT’s Northern Region, Albany Division, Niagara Subdivision, extending from milepost QDJ 0.94 to the end of track at milepost QDJ 2.0, in North Tonawanda, Niagara County, New York (the “Line”). The exemption became effective on January 31, 2009.

Pursuant to the provisions of 49 C.F.R. 1152.29(e)(2), CSXT hereby files its notice of consummation signifying that it has exercised its abandonment authority and fully abandoned the Line as of the date of this letter.
