**Re: STB Docket No. AB-55 (Sub-No. 688X), CSX Transportation, Inc. --
Abandonment Exemption – in Marion County, IN**

Dear Ms. Brown:

By decision served on October 3, 2008, the Board exempted from further regulation the abandonment by CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) of a 1.01 mile line of railroad, known as the Arlington Industrial Track, located on its Northern Region, Great Lakes Division, Indianapolis Belt Subdivision, extending from milepost QIA 1.11 (English Ave.) to the end of the track at milepost QIA 0.1 in Marion County, Indiana.

By decision and notice of interim trail use or abandonment (NITU) served November 3, 2008, the Board reopened the proceeding and authorized the Indiana Trails Fund, Inc. (“ITF”) to negotiate for interim trail use/rail banking with CSXT. Subsequently, the parties to the NITU were granted an extension of the NITU deadline, but were not able to reach agreement, and have not renewed their request for a further extension.

Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of 49 C.F.R. 1152.29(e)(2), CSX Transportation, Inc. (“CSXT”) hereby files its notice of consummation signifying that it has exercised its abandonment authority and fully abandoned the Line as of the date of this letter.
