Movant is submitting simultaneously with this motion, an offer of financial assistance, to wit to purchase the trackage rights which the Delaware and Hudson Railway, Inc. seeks to discontinue. In order to establish that CNJ is a financially responsible party, the net worth statement of its principle, William Strohmeyer, is submitted as an exhibit, marked personal and confidential.

Wherefore CNJ Rail Corporation and William Strohmeyer respectfully request that the subject personal net worth statement be maintained as confidential and not be made part of the public record.
