

Enclosed for filing please find eleven (11) copies of a letter containing information provided to Mr. Joseph Levine concerning C&G's proposed abandonment of a segment of main line track within the City of Greenwood, Mississippi. C&G has not yet filed in this docket because of the burden of responding in a separate docket and because of uncertainty about the section of the Code of Federal Regulations pursuant to which it will file. The uncertainty has been created by claims of a party who previously shipped on the line.

Mr. Roger Bell, C&G's President and Chief Executive Officer, has indicated that CN has been notified that the filing date in the letter will be changed. A new date has not yet been set.

Dear Mr. Bell

This is in reference to the removal of the Interlocking at Greenwood, Mississippi.

It has been agreed upon between the Illinois Central Railroad Company, ("IC") a wholly owned subsidiary of the Canadian National Railway Company and Columbus and Greenville Railway Company ("CAGY") that if the CAGY needs to access the area that would have been considered the Northeast quadrant at Milepost 122.5 on the Yazoo Subdivision in Greenwood, MS to provide service for an active rail customer requiring rail service at this location, the IC will arrange for the CAGY to have operating rights to access the above quadrant.

It is further understood that the CAGY will file by June 30, 2005 to abandon the above location.

This letter agreement will terminate upon STB approval of the abandonment or December 31, 2005 whichever comes first.
