The City of Greenwood, Mississippi, in this abandonment procedure on December 5, 2005, filed its request for an issuance of a public use condition under 49 U.S.C. §10905 and on January 10, 2006, filed its request for an order to establish interim trail use and rail banking under 16 U.S.C. § 1247(d) and 49 C.F.R. §1152.29 on the section of track to which abandonment has been requested by the Columbus & Greenville Railway Company.

In these filings referenced above, the City of Greenwood failed to request or designate a time period to negotiate with the Columbus & Greenville Railway Co. for the public use exception as required by 49 C.F.R. §1152.28 and for the interim trail use and rail banking as required by 49 C.F.R. §1152.29.

In order to allow adequate time with which to negotiate with the Columbus & Greenville

Railway Co. concerning the special use exception and the interim trail use, the City of Greenwood requests the statutory maximum of 180 days be authorized for both the special use exception and the interim trail use request.
